## ***SPEAKER BIOS***



**Barbara Liu, M.D., FRCP(C), FRCP(Edin)**

Dr. Barbara Liu is the Executive Director of the Regional Geriatric Program of Toronto (RGP), Program Director of the Geriatric Medicine subspecialty training program and Associate Professor of Medicine at the University of Toronto. Dr. Liu has worked to promote the RGP's senior friendly hospital framework with decision makers, hospitals and front-line providers. She is the co-principal investigator for the successful, multi-site, project, Mobilization of Vulnerable Elders in Ontario (MOVE ON), which promotes mobilization of seniors in hospital. Through her clinical work and administrative leadership, she is deeply committed to the care of older people in Ontario and the RGP's vision of "Better health outcome for frail seniors".



**Kelly Kay**

Kelly is the Executive Director of the Seniors Care Network, a coordinating entity for all specialized geriatric services (SGS) in the Central East LHIN. Kelly is a seasoned health administrator whose accomplishments include the design, implementation and coordination of large-scale, yet grassroots, regional programs.

Kelly holds a Masters in Leadership (Health Specialization) from Royal Roads University and is currently pursuing PhD studies at the University of Toronto, Ontario Institute for Studies in Education. Her research interests include the engagement of older adults in community-based health service design and interprofessional geriatric/gerontological care. Kelly completed an Interdisciplinary Fellowship with the Canadian Frailty Network in 2015, and studied the application of telemedicine technology to community-based geriatric care. She is a member of Canadian Frailty Network's Citizen Engagement Committee and is an Adjunct Professor in the Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of Ontario Institute of Technology (UOIT).



**Kelly Milne**

Kelly is the Director for the Regional Geriatric Program of Eastern Ontario, which is located at the Ottawa Hospital. The RGP is focused on providing a coordinated network of specialized geriatric services, from hospital to home. Our clinical services, teaching and research are committed to optimizing the health and independence of seniors in the Champlain region.

Kelly has been active in working with community partners and hospitals in promoting better care, better value and better health in responding to the health care needs of older adults. Some initiatives such as Senior Friendly Hospital Strategy and GEM plus highlight some of the system capacity building to address the above.

Kelly is co-chair of the RGP<sub>s</sub> of Ontario and the Champlain Dementia Network and chairs the Champlain Fall Prevention Steering Committee.
